COST

The cost is \$6 per person per program for registrations received before 12:00 p.m. the day before the program. The cost is \$8 per person per program for registrations received after 12:00 p.m. the day before the program. SCIturdays Annual Subscriptions are available for a discounted cost of \$48 per person and include nine 2nd Saturday programs OR nine 4th Saturday programs. Discounts cannot be combined and no other discounts apply. ALL participants pay the admission fee (children and adults). The 10:00 a.m. - 12:00 p.m. and 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. programs are two separate programs; the 1:00 p.m. program is a repeat of the 10:00 a.m. program. Cost includes all materials.

PRE-REGISTRATION

The registration form must be completed and submitted before 12:00 p.m. the day before the program to receive the discount (\$6). Registration is complete and confirmed on receipt of completed registration form and full payment. Programs are limited in size; therefore, registrations will be processed on a first come, first serve basis. Registration after 12:00 p.m. the day before the program or at the door is also accepted, if space permits, and costs \$8 per person per program.

NO-SHOW POLICY

If a registered participant does not arrive 15 minutes after the start of the program, they will be considered a no-show. No-show spots are non-refundable and will be made available to walk-up customers, if applicable.
